

Medicare Moment: It's time to start preparing now for 2025!

Regarding the information in the Medicare article in July's GSC newsletter, here's what you can do now to understand how you could be impacted by the changes in Medicare as a result of the Inflation Reduction Act.

- 1. Each year your health plan sends you the Annual Notice of Change (ANOC) in late September. This is a description of changes to your specific Medicare prescription drug plan or Medicare advantage plan. It has a table of the current cost for services and the changes for the next year. Review it carefully.
- 2. Medicare Annual Enrollment is October 15th to December 7th. This window gives you an opportunity to add, drop, or change your current coverage for the upcoming year, which will become effective on January 1, 2025.
- 3. Additionally, as of October 1st, you can review your medication costs to see how the upcoming changes, including how the removal of the coverage gap (donut hole) and the capping of the cost of prescription medications at \$2,000 for the year will affect you. You can review these on your own at Medicare.gov or consult a Medicare broker to be your guide through the maze of Medicare. Take action to be sure you are prepared for 2025!
